Subject: CVS Health/Omnicare Guidance on Face Coverings and Temperature Checks

Dear Valued Courier,

Aligned to the updated [CDC announcement loosening restrictions on face coverings](#) for fully COVID-19 vaccinated individuals, CVS Health has updated our face covering and temperature check guidance for colleagues and customers, effective Friday, May 21, 2021.

Key Points:

- Effective **Friday, May 21, 2021**, fully-vaccinated colleagues working in non-clinical roles will no longer be required to wear face coverings in our locations, except where state and local mandates require continued mask wearing. This updated guidance includes all CVS Health office locations, retail stores, pharmacies and distribution centers. *Colleagues who prefer to continue to wear a face covering in their work setting may continue to do so.*
- Omnicare colleagues must continue to wear face coverings, regardless of individual vaccination status, when visiting facilities or interacting with residents. This also applies to pharmacists and technicians administering immunizations.
- Non-vaccinated colleagues continue to be required to wear face coverings in all settings.
- Colleagues will be asked to complete an attestation regarding their vaccination status.
- Non-colleagues visiting Omnicare locations or facilities should follow these guidelines and wear a mask if not vaccinated and perform routine health checks. Please refrain from visiting an Omnicare location or facility if you're demonstrating any symptoms of COVID-19 or other illness. At this time, we are not asking non-colleagues to complete a formal attestation.
